<p>The writing is an explanation of the materials' main ideas or details, explained in the student's own words, except for material quoted from the source. (7-2.5)</p>		
<p>The writing contains 4 or more paragraphs that include an introduction, supporting facts, statistics or examples, and a conclusion. (6-1.2)</p>		
<p>The writer uses transitions between sentences and paragraphs to unify ideas. (7-1.1)</p>		
<p>If the source contains an underlying meaning, the writing reflects it and not just the superficial details. (7-2.5)</p>		
<p>The writer uses a variety of sentence types. (8-1.1)</p>		
<p>The writing contains few errors in grammar, punctuation, capitalization and spelling, and these errors do not interfere with the reader's understanding.</p>
