RELEASE OF DIRECTORY INFORMATION

KCSOS recognizes the importance of maintaining the confidentiality of directory information and therefore authorizes the release of such information, including to news media or nonprofit organizations, in accordance with law, Superintendent Policy, and administrative regulation.

The release of specific categories of directory information may be limited or denied to any public or private nonprofit organization based on a determination of the best interests of KCSOS students. (Education Code 49073)

A student's directory information shall only be included in the minutes of the Board's meeting in accordance with Board Policy 9320 – Notices, Minutes and Recordings.

Colleges and prospective employers, including military recruiters, shall have access to a student's name, address, email address, and telephone number, unless the student's parent/guardian, or student, if the student is 18 years of age or older, has requested that such information not be released. (10 USC 503, 20 USC 7908)

Under no circumstances shall directory information be disclosed to a private profit-making entity, except for representatives of the news media and employers, including prospective employers, in accordance with law, Superintendent Policy, and administrative regulation. Private schools and colleges may be given the names and addresses of 12th-grade students and students who are no longer enrolled, provided that they use this information only for purposes directly related to the institution's academic or professional goals. (Education Code 49073)
