SUBJECT: Transition of QSS to QCC Print Option - July 1, 2014

The External Business Department has been working with districts over the last few years to get all QSS users converted to the new QCC system. As the next step, we need to begin shutting down portions of the QSS system. As a result, the QSS Print Option will no longer be available after July 1, 2014.

In order to accomplish this, all users will need to be using the new QCC Print Manager to manage and print reports. Most QSS users are already using the QCC Print Manager and realize the ease of the process and recognize the increased capabilities of the QCC Print Manager.

If you are not currently using QCC Print Manager and do not have a QCC user name and password, please contact us at BASS@kern.org to get set up with one. To assist in the transition, we are holding Print Manager trainings every month along with a QCC HOT Lab (Hands- on-Training Lab) every other Tuesday.
