

During the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) school closure, the KCSOS Nutrition Services Department will provide families with the opportunity to pick up meals for their children at no cost. Lunch will be provided, along with breakfast for the next day, between 11 a.m and 1 p.m., Monday through Friday, at the locations listed below. Children 18 and under must be present to receive their meal. Meal service is “Grab N Go” and may not be consumed on premises.

Service line options will include a drive-thru (in the parking lot) and a pick-up table for those families walking to the campus. When going through the drive-thru, please stay in your vehicle. Meals for the children will be passed through based on the number of children in the car.

All Kern County Children 18 years and younger are encouraged to look at their local school district’s webpage for specific locations and times.

If participation numbers at a school site are too low to support being opened, school sites may be consolidated during the closure. Meals cannot be consumed on the site. We encourage families to continue to be proactive in reducing the risk of COVID-19 by not congregating at the school site once meals have been distributed. Continue to wash your hands often, sneeze or cough into a tissue, and stay home if you are sick.
