GUEST SERVICES MANAGER CALIFORNIA LIVING MUSEUM (CALM)

DEFINITION

The Guest Services Manager plans, directs and evaluates activities related to enhancing the guest and team member experience including the Gift Store, Events, Parking, Guest Assistance, and Public Safety.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Prepare daily reports such as Fiscal, Attendance, Inventory, and Business Office;

purchase, maintain, and monitor inventory;

oversee office supply orders;

manage pricing and promote sales;

oversee cash handling procedures;

maintain weekly schedules of events and rentals;

oversee re-structure and design;

ensure merchandise is up to date and keep track of trending items;

answer phones as well as handle other communications;

carry out hiring of staff and facilitate training;

assume a leadership role in Guest Services for CALM;

provide direct oversite of GSEA team;

schedule staffing for events;

ensure zoo maps are up to date;

coordinate field trips to the CALM;

plan events in coordination with the Volunteer and Community Engagement Facilitator;

expand and maintain Reciprocal Membership Agreements;

perform member outreach duties; provide customer service and communicate with the public;

utilize venue management software;

coordinate with Zoo Curator for animal intake procedures;

coordinate with Zoo Facilities and Operations Manager for project/grounds needs.

QUALIFICATIONS

<u>Knowledge of:</u> Practices of inventory management;

principles and practices of supervision;

up to date practices as relates to merchandise;

budget management practices.

<u>Ability to:</u> Communicate clearly and concisely, both orally and in writing;

establish and maintain cooperative working relationships;

prepare and maintain reports and records;

lift 50 lbs. on a regular basis;

supervise and train assigned staff to ensure outstanding service;

Work closely and communicate regularly with other managers to maximize the guest experience in accordance with the Zoo's Mission and Values.

Experience:

Three (3) years of increasingly responsible experience in the oversight of a retail establishment. Prior experience supervising employees preferred.

Education:

High School diploma or equivalent.

Conditions of employment:
