FEEDING AIDE

DEFINITION

Under supervision, to perform a variety of child care activities that occur within the feeding program established in the classroom.

EXAMPLE OF DUTIES

Assist instructional personnel with feeding activities including, but not limited to, obtaining the food from the cafeteria;

preparing special textures for individual students;

feeding students or assisting students who feed themselves;

cleaning areas used for feeding;

cleaning and toileting individual students;

assist in moving students from one area to another;

assist in maintaining appropriate behavior standards in the feeding program.

QUALIFICATIONS

<u>Knowledge of</u>: Food preparation;

safe working methods and procedures.

Ability to:

Use the English language, as required by the assignment, at a level sufficient to fulfill the duties to be performed;

demonstrate an understanding, patient and receptive attitude toward severely handicapped students;

comply with appropriate cleanliness and health standards;

lift 50 pounds;

establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with children and adults.

Experience

Experience working with pre-school age and/or severely handicapped children desirable.

<u>Education</u> Appropriate to the assignment.

Conditions of Employment:

A preplacement medical assessment/health screening, at office expense, is a condition of appointment after all other required job conditions have been met.

Some positions may require proof of privately owned automobile insurance and possession of a valid California Motor Vehicle operator's license which must be maintained for the duration of the assignment.

Fingerprint clearance by both the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the California Department of Justice is a condition of appointment after all other required job conditions have been met.
