

## W.A. Kendrick Elementary School





**Kindergarten Readiness: Children enter school ready to learn.** Students have the opportunity to attend preschool through one of two GFUSD state funded preschools. Transitional Kindergarten is offered to students who meet the age requirements. Teachers meet with upcoming kindergarten parents in the spring to inform of expectations of kindergarten. Students go through a screening process through Core Growth Assessment.

3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Literacy and 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Proficiency: children read at grade level by end of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and demonstrate core math proficiencies by the end of 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Performance tasks created by teachers and leadership team. One performance task per trimester in ELA and math K-5.Running record assessment – took Lexile levels of common core/SBAC. STAR is used for all students to maximize learning time and minimize testing time. Guided Reading used for intervention.

8<sup>th</sup> grade literacy and math proficiency: Students demonstrate reading and math proficiency by the end of 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Not applicable to W.A. Kendrick Elementary School
