Named by the founding foster youth who helped design services, we assist current and former foster youth up to age 25 with successful transitioning to adulthood. More than 700 youth receive Dream Center services each year.

#### **Dream Center Services**

- Counseling
- Assistance accessing and completing educational and vocational programs
- Assistance with building life skills
- Assistance with CalFresh and MediCal
- Assistance with employment
- Resource Information and referral
- Shower and laundry facilities for homeless youth
- Social events that help youth develop social connections
- Support and advocacy
