- 1. Parental Resilience-The ability of parents to manage stress and function well when faced with challenges and adversity.
- 2. Social Connections-The ability to develop positive relationships with family, friends, neighbors, and others to have a support network.
- **Concrete Support-**The ability to access basic necessities that everyone deserves, medical, mental health, social, educational, legal services.
- **Knowledge of Parenting** and Child Development-Learning about prenatal, infant, and child development, and using developmentally and contextually appropriate parenting practices
- **Social & Emotional** Competence of Children-The ability of children to understand and label their emotions and the emotions of others and to form positive relationships with other children and adults.
