District support

Provide feedback and assistance in the provision of special education services through site visits and consultation

Field support

Coach and provide technical assistance for district personnel enrolled in SELPA professional development series

Centralized comprehensive staff development

Develop and provide comprehensive series based on evidence based practices to enhance implementation of special education programs

Collaborative workgroups

Offer leadership in collaborative workgroups that address specific topics of interest in special education

Evidence based practice resources

Produce staff development resources for district use on specific topics that address special education processes and practices

Provide workshops for parents to enhance knowledge of evidence based practices and special education systems
