District Support

Provide feedback and assistance in the provision of special education services through site visits and consultation

Coaching for Specialized Personnel

Coach and provide technical assistance for district personnel enrolled in SELPA professional development series

Centralized & Regionalized Comprehensive Staff Development

Develop and provide comprehensive series based on evidence based practices to enhance implementation of special education programs

Collaborative Workgroups

Offer leadership in collaborative workgroups that address specific topics of interest in special education

Evidence Based Practice Resources

Current research available via SELPA website on evidence based practices

Child Find (Search and Serve)

Operate Online referral system and conduct robust outreach for identifying children in the community that may be impacted by a disability and may qualify for Early Start/SPED services

Parent Trainings

Provide workshops for parents to enhance knowledge of evidence based practices and special education systems

LCAP and Differentiated Assistance Support

Collaborate with COE is providing support to member LEAs in development of LCAP and addressing areas of Differentiated Assistance for SWDs

Continuing Education Units

Provide workshops that include CEUs for select providers.

CPI Training

Centrally based Nonviolent Crisis Intervention® full and refresher certifications provided on an annual basis

Embedded Professional Development

Collaborate with district and site level professional learning communities and support other established professional development initiatives

Compliance and Improvement Support

Share feedback and provide guidance on state performance plans and indicators

Program Transfer Support

Work with implementation team to plan and execute program transfer

SPED Data Support

Work with individual districts as necessary to ensure accurate data submission to CDE

SPED Fiscal Support

Distribute yearly forms and provide support for all SPED EOY fiscal reporting

Designated Instructional Services (DIS)
