Contributing Factors to student learning outcomes:


#1) 15 to 1 student to teacher ratio plus aides in the classroom which lends itself to differentiation of instruction

- Diagnostic done continuously due to small group ratio
- Small classes can meet their needs of all students
- Reteach and extended learning opportunities
- Higher expectations
- Can't hide from the teacher
- Ability to slow down the curriculum from 5to 8 days as needed for student learning
- Allows for combo classes to be successful

#2) Programs used to fidelity throughout all grades.

- Early subject matter exposure -Students learn from each other with combo classes i.e. First grade instruction is heard and learned by Kindergarten students

# Rallies and Awards Assemblies

One academic rally a year, usually first quarter awards assembly. We have a total of 4 awards assemblies recognizing and celebrating student's successes on Tiger levels and Tiger Stars. We pick a theme and decorate auditorium for first quarter academic rally.

## Tiger Levels (Honor Roll) Gold - 4.0

Silver - 3.5 - 3.99 Bronze - 3.0 - 3.49

2.9 GPA or lower and shows good citizenship (TIGER Way Core Values) and maximum effort on school work and homework. Kindergarten through 2nd grade are selected on same criteria except grades are not earned.

# Citizenship Award (TIGER Way)

Teacher selects one student from their class each quarter and those students are recognized at awards assemblies. They receive a metal and are celebrated for their outstanding behavior. They are recognized with a teacher write-up of why they were selected as they walk onto stage.

Perfect attendance for each quarter.

Top Readers with the most points earned from each grade are recognized at awards assemblies.

Two discipline reports knocks student off awards assemblies and field trips for each quarter
