School Profile

Kendrick Elementary School is a suburban school that houses 777 TK-5th grade students. The school is led by Dr. Suleiman who insists on a culture of academic excellence. "The Kendrick Way – we are here to make children successful" is a prominent message throughout the campus. In addition to the grade level teaching staff, the school also touts a music teacher, librarian, social worker, academic coach, 2 learning centers for grade level spans, and an assistant principal.

School Demographics

The student population consists of 83.1% Hispanic and Latino, 7.1% African American, and 5.5% white. The subgroups within this population are as follows: 93% Socioeconomically Disadvantaged, 15.6% English Learners, 6% Students with Disabilities, and 4% Migrant Education.




Contributing/ Replicable Factors

- Google Presentations required from each student. To improve speaking, listening, and vocabulary, Kendrick Elementary implemented presentations at every grade level.
- Strong expectation in writing every day and integrated in all subjects- including math
- Challenges for classes with friendly competitions. Focus for challenges rotate each month between Reading, Attendance, and Behavior.
- Performance tasks created by teachers and leadership team. One performance task per trimester in ELA and math, K-5th grades.
- Guided Reading
- <u>Rubrics</u> created and followed by every teacher in every grade level K-5
 - Reading Level Rubric created according to STAR scaled scores and adopted by all teachers
 - o Presentation rubric
 - Writing rubrics:

 - Informative
 - Student Collaboration

On-going assessments

- <u>Running Record assessment</u> Took Lexile levels of common core/SBAC. Shared results with teachers and parent. Not a Universal Screener, but for diagnostic purposes.
- STAR is used for all students to maximize learning time and minimize testing time.





Social Emotional Learning

- Full time psychologist provides Professional Development to help demystify behaviors and teaching teachers how to look for and manage behaviors especially in younger grades.
- PBIS Tier 2 and 3 use check in check out with behavior intervention assistant
- Part time School Social Worker
