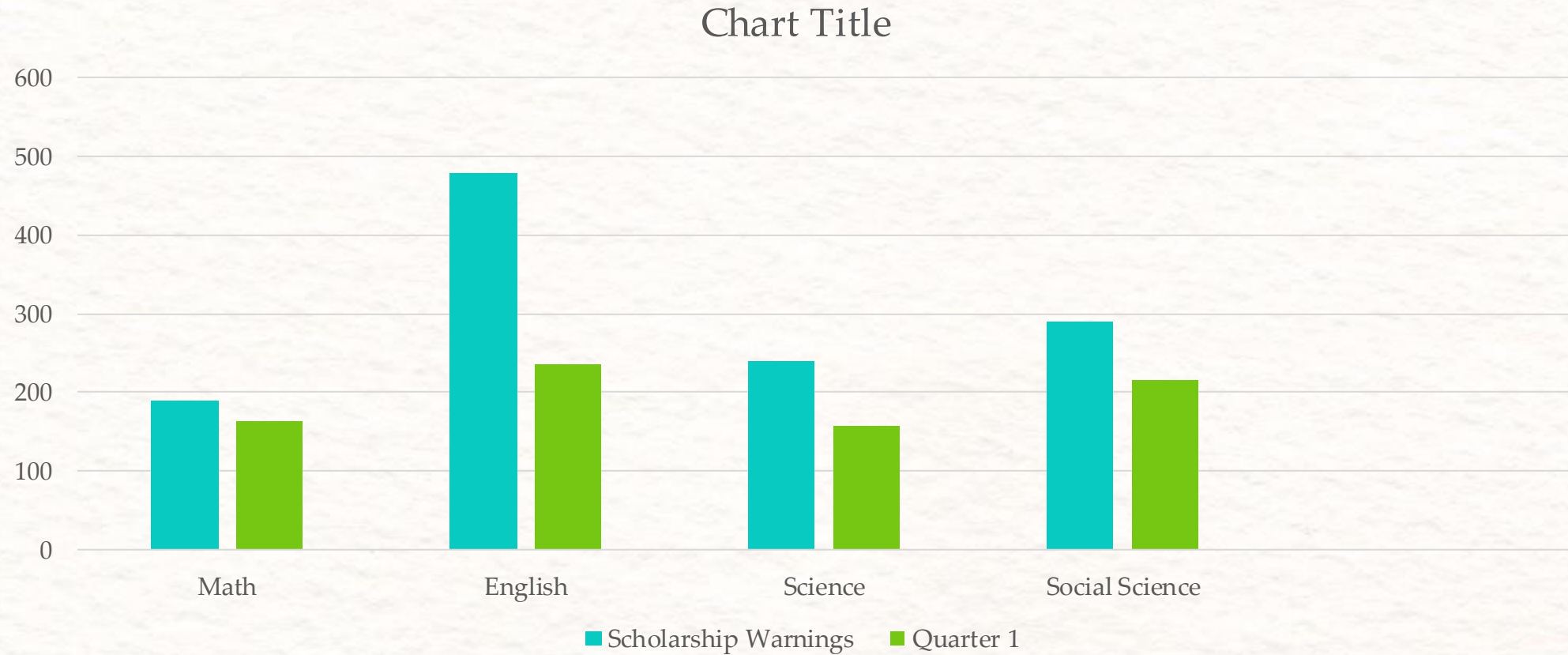


# Good News



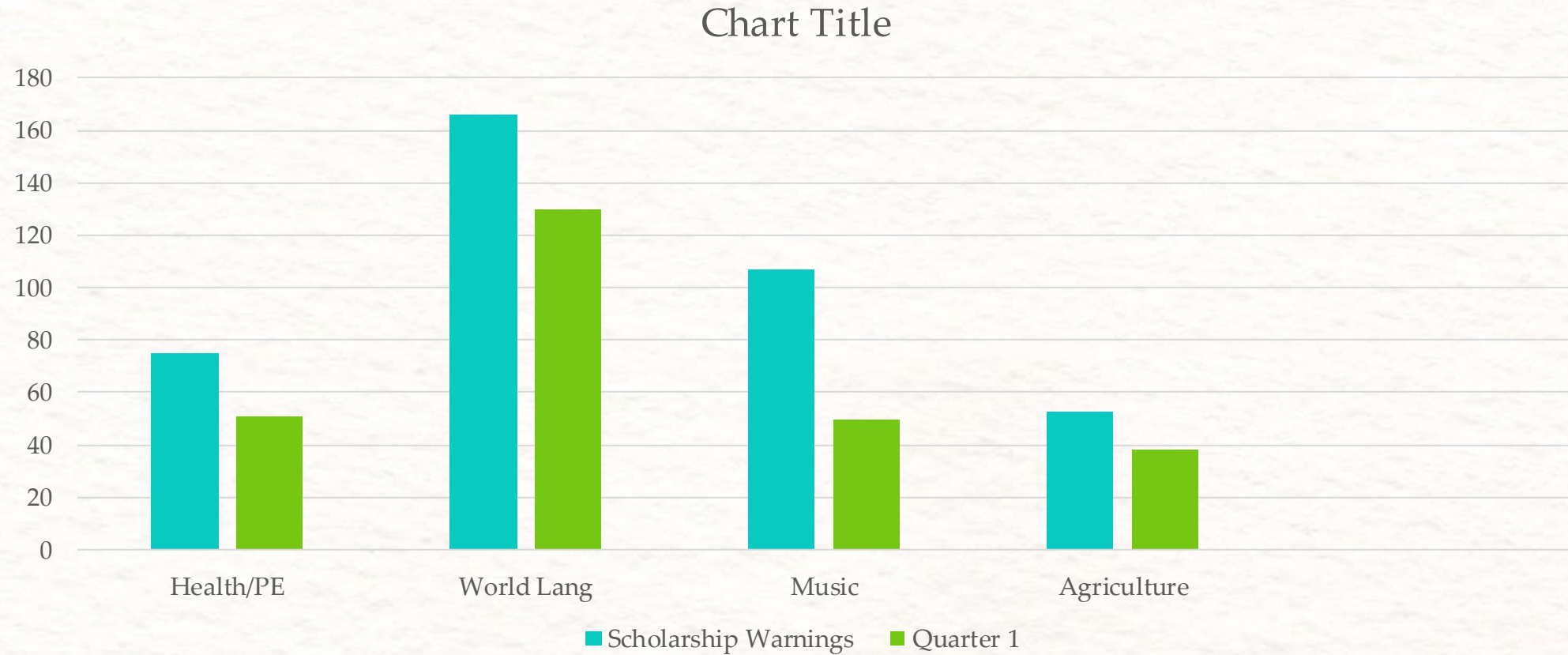
- Over 160 students have straight As!

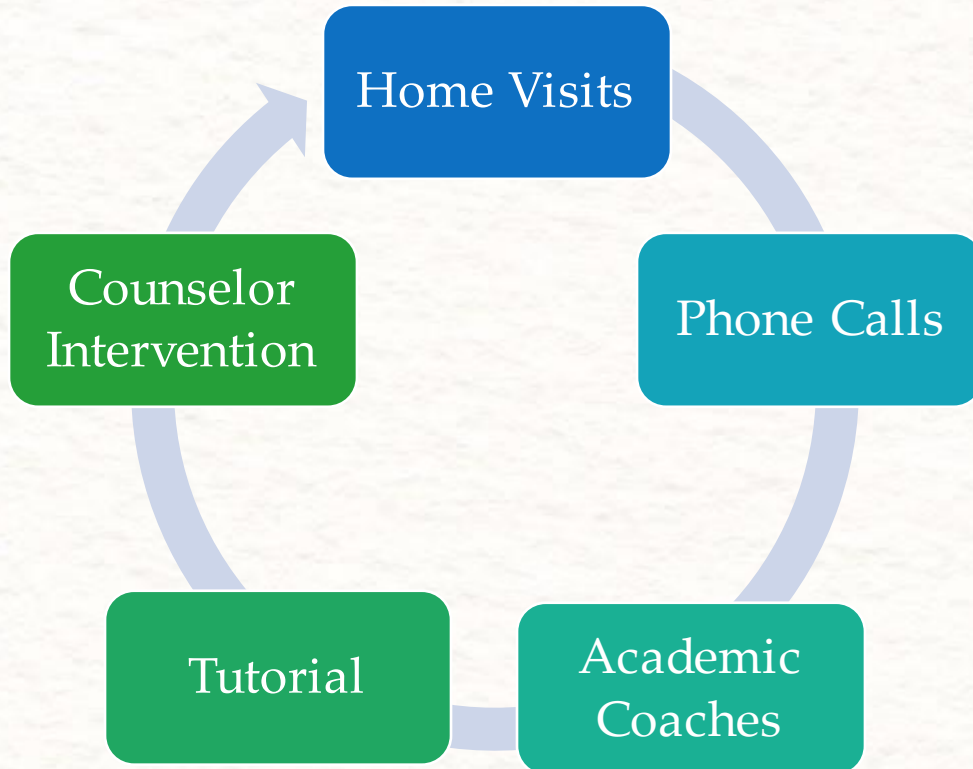

# Some Next Steps to Increase Student Achievement



- Home Visits for Students with 5 or more F's
- Support Staff Phone Calls and TEAMS messages for students with 3 or more F's
- Academic coaches to work with departments on strategies to support struggling students
- EL/Reclassified student monitoring process
- Counselors to continue to call students of concern and work with them appropriately
- Encourage tutorial attendance

# Academic Coaches Roles and Responsibilities

- Plans and provides high-quality, personalized professional dev that is evidence-based for teachers
- Provides methodologies and instructional strategies that strengthen the classroom and increase the amount and quality of learning time
- Assist in developing activities that increase the ability of teachers to effectively teach students of all sub groups
- Model innovating teaching methodologies through team teaching and demo lessons
- Provide support and assistance to teachers in developing classroom management strategies
- Establish and maintain a trustful, confidential, and non-evaluative relationship with teachers
- Conducts classroom observations and provides "next step" support for teachers
