Kindergarten Readiness: Children enter school ready to learn.

Kindergarten Readiness tests are given prior to their Franklin experience. Transitional Kindergarten is offered to students as well as preschool for those who do not qualify for TK. Uniform assessment is used by all TK and K classes – Core Growth Test. Staff is able to identify strengths and weaknesses for each student.



3rd Grade Literacy and 5th grade math proficiency: Children read at grade level by the end of 3rd grade and demonstrate core math proficiencies by the end of 5th grade.

Math Action Plan, Math journals that are interactive, Number Talks and hand signals, used during math. ELA includes Balanced Literacy, writing with peer editing, Guided Reading applied, Achieve 3000 helps with informational text at student's ability level. Gradual Release of Responsibility Model is used by all teachers.



 8^{th} grade literacy & math proficiency: Students demonstrate reading and math proficiency by the end of 8^{th} grade.
