### **KERN STARTS**

Kindergarten Readiness: Children enter school ready to learn: McKittrick has a unique Kindergarten program that caps out at 8 students. Students receive extra care and resources during the formative years so they are better equipped for their educational pathway. AIMS web data helps to narrow the focus of the needs. The Principal/Superintendent is in close contact with the kindergarten teacher, students and their parents.



### **KERN READS**

3<sup>rd</sup> grade Literacy and 5<sup>th</sup> grade math proficiency: There is a generational tradition among McKittrick families that include the “corrections” program. Students are to take assignments home for mastery of the subject and continue to take home the assignment until it meets the expectations of the rubric. This leads to 5<sup>th</sup> grade proficiency and the impressive scores that show on the dashboard for 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. AIMS web and 1 to 8 educator to students ratio ensures that students are readers by 3<sup>rd</sup> grade.



### **KERN COUNTS**

8<sup>th</sup> grade Literacy and Math Proficiency: Students demonstrate reading and math proficiency by the end of 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Students are expected to come to class ready to learn. “Corrections” continue through 8<sup>th</sup> grade in math. AIMS web identifies students’ specific are of need and due to the 1 to 8 ratio, the students receive immediate attention with strategies that are tailored to their needs.
