### II. HEARING OF CITIZENS

The Board of Education appreciates comments from members of the public, who have the opportunity to address the Board on agenda items (before the Board's consideration of the item) and on other matters within the Board's jurisdiction.

To move the meeting business along efficiently, individual speakers are allotted up to three minutes each, and the total time for comment on each agenda item or other topic within the Board's jurisdiction will be limited to 20 minutes. In exceptional circumstances, the Board President may, with Board consent, reduce or increase the amount of time allowed for public

input and/or the time allotted for each speaker, when such adjustment is necessary to ensure full opportunity for public input within the time allotted. Any such adjustment shall be done in an equitable manner, so as to allow a diversity of viewpoints. The President may also ask members of the public with the same viewpoint to select a few individuals to address the Board regarding that viewpoint.

To allow the Board to organize the public comments, persons wishing to speak will need to fill out a form before the meeting begins, providing a name and the agenda item or other topic within the Board's jurisdiction on which they wish to speak. Items not appearing on the agenda cannot, by law, be the subject of board action.
