BOARD BYLAWS

SUPERVISION OF INSTRUCTION IN SCHOOLS OPERATED BY THE KERN COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS OFFICE

The Kern County Board of Education shall exercise authority over instructional programs operated by the Kern County Superintendent of Schools Office in the manner prescribed by law, as follows:

1. Where the county superintendent exercises discretion, with state approval to operate an ROP/C, the county board shall function as the governing board for that program.
2. The county board authorizes the operating of community school programs to be administered by the county superintendent.
3. The county board authorizes the county superintendent to administer and operate juvenile court schools
4. For each instructional program authorized under this policy, the county board shall adopt the curriculum on recommendation of the county superintendent.
5. At least once annually, the county superintendent shall report to the county board regarding these instructional programs so that the county board may evaluate them.
