

KERN COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION**BOARD BYLAWS****AUTHORIZATION TO THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT TO PROVIDE SPECIFIC SERVICES TO DISTRICTS**

The legislature has declared its intent that the county superintendent provides coordination of the educational program among the school districts and community college districts in the county and provides professional and financial assistance to districts that, because of their size or remote location, can benefit from that assistance to furnish satisfactory educational programs for their students. The county board encourages the county superintendent to maintain a cooperative relationship with districts to accomplish these goals.

The county board, in accordance with statute, authorizes the county superintendent to cooperate with districts and other agencies in offering the following services where they are requested and needed, and to pay for those services in whole or part from the county school services fund:

1. Preparation of courses of study and development of curriculum and instructional materials.
2. Participation in projects for developmental program planning.
3. Supervision of instruction.
4. Supervision of attendance.
5. Supervision of health.
6. Guidance services.
7. Library services.
8. Youth conservation and training.
9. Audio and visual curriculum materials.
10. Education in county correctional facilities.
11. The miscellaneous services described in Education Code sections 1940 and following.

Nothing in this policy shall limit the authority and discretion of the county superintendent to enter into agreements or the joint exercise of powers to provide additional services for which approval of the county board is not expressly required by statute.
